

***Erigeron uncialis* Blake var. *conjugans* (Blake)****INCH HIGH FLEABANE**

**FAMILY:** *Asteraceae*, the sunflower family.

**STATUS:** **Heritage Program WATCH LIST, ranks: G3G4 T3? S3?**

**USFWS/ESA:** none. **STATE OF NEVADA:** none. **BLM:** none. **USFS:** none. **NNNPS:** none.

**POPULATION CENSUS:** **7 occurrences mapped;** total estimated **individuals unknown**, total estimated **area unknown**.

**TREND:** unknown.

**IMPACTS AND MAJOR THREATS:** No summary available (see references).

**INVENTORY EFFORT:** Not yet systematically surveyed. Most recent entered survey 1987, average year of last survey 1968. **Years since last entered survey** (percent of mapped records at various survey ages): **11-20 yrs:** 25%; **21-30 yrs:** 50%; **51+ yrs or unknown:** 25%.

**LAND MANAGEMENT** in decreasing predominance: Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, designated wilderness, private lands, U. S. Bureau of Land Management, Nevada state lands (?).

**RANGE:** Clark, Lincoln, Nye, and White Pine (?) counties, Nevada. Known only from the Spring, Sheep, and Quinn Canyon ranges. **Nevada endemic.** Maximum **range dimension 216.3 km (134.4 mi)** excluding most disjunct record. **Type specimen** collected in Clark County.

**ELEVATIONS RECORDED:** 5400-11100 feet (1646-3383 meters).

**HABITAT:** Carbonate outcrops and crevices in the pinyon-juniper, montane conifer, and subalpine conifer zones.

**PHENOLOGY:** flowering late-spring to summer, May through July. Range of most frequent **survey months:** June-July.

**LIFE-FORM AND HABIT:** small matted perennial herb.

**DESCRIPTION:** not available (see references).

**PHOTOGRAPHS:** none known.
